SUBJECT:

*“Seven (7) Draft Resolutions Commending the Awardees in the 2024 Seal of Good local Governance for Barangay (SGLGB)- sponsored by Hon. Ronaldo S. Ortiz et.al.”*

FINDINGS:

1. The Seal of Good Governance for Barangay (SGLGB) is a performance assessments and recognition system that aims to give distinction to barangays with remarkable performance across various governance areas.
2. This program of the DILG aims to encourage barangays to continuously progress in delivering efficient, equitable and quality public services. It puts primacy to integrity and good performance as pillars of meaningful local autonomy and development.

3. In order to qualify in the Seal of Good Local Governance for Barangay (SGLGB), barangay units must adhere to three core governance areas; namely, financial management/administration, disaster preparedness and public safety.
4. Out of the several barangay units in the entire Philippines that Seal of Good Local Governance for Barangay (SGLGB) has evaluated, seven barangays of Tuguegarao City have satisfactorily passed the assessment indicators, thus achieving the national passers status.
5. The Tuguegarao City Government commends the noteworthy accomplishment of the seven barangays namely: Barangay Tanza, Cataggaman Nuevo, Capatan, Caritan Centro, San Gabriel, Centro 06 and Pengue Ruyu for bringing pride and honor to the city.
