COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 93-2025

SUBJECT:

"Letter of the DPWH Cagayan 3rd Engineering Office on the proposed one-way traffic along Pattaui Street (Pallua Road) relative to the ongoing construction of a drainage project"

ACTION TAKEN:

The members of the committees met to discuss the subject matter with the presence of the resource persons.

FINDINGS:

1.) In a letter dated March 14, 2025, the OIC of the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Cagayan Third District Engineering Office (CTDEO), Engr. Esmeralda O. De Guzman requested the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que for a one-way flow of traffic from the triangle intersection of Luna Street and Pattaui St. (Pallua Road) to Maya St. intersection leading to San Gabriel.

- 2.) This is due to an ongoing construction of drainage project by the DPWH under GAA FY 2024 project entitled "Construction of Drainage System Along Pallua, Tuguegarao City, Cagayan, Phase III".
- 3.) The progress for the construction along this project is approaching Luna St. and Pattaui St. (Pallua Road) intersection.
- 4.) DPWH stated that the project spans 268 meters and that it would take two (2) months for the project to be completed.
- 5.) The implementation of a possible one-way traffic flow along the subject road is expected to cause heavier congestion and further inconvenience for the riding public, given the longer distances and additional time required to navigate alternative routes.

RECOMMENDATION:

After discussing thoroughly the subject matter, the Committee does NOT recommend the declaration of temporary one-way traffic flow of the requested road. The Committee instead recommends the following:

- a) For the Traffic Management Group and Barangay Ugac Norte to assist and facilitate traffic along the subject road.
- b) For the contractor to deploy flagmen to assist the TMG and barangay officials.
- c) For the gradual excavation and construction of the project in 50-meter sections at a time until completion.
- d) For the Barangay to clear the subject road, including but not limited to prohibiting vehicles from parking along its shoulders.
- e) For the POSO/TMG to install early warning signage, disseminate relevant information, and advise commuters of alternate routes in order to avoid the subject road.

Let a copy of this Committee Report be furnished to the Office of the Honorable City Mayor, DPWH-CTDEO, and Barangay Ugac Norte.
