On CDC Resolution No. 06-2025

- There are increases in some of the budgetary amount of priority programs and projects in the approved LDIP 2023-2028.
- 2. There were new priority programs and projects (PPAs) which were not included in the approved LDIP 2023-2028 and other PPAs mentioned during the CDC meeting which need funding for implementation and to integrate such PPAs and other items of expenditure in the LDIP as supplements thereof.

On CDC Resolution No. 07-2025

- 1. The Personnel Services of the Local Government Unit of Tuguegarao City is a major component of the Supplemental Annual Investment Program (SAIP) by virtue of Executive Order No. 64, Section 04 dated August 2, 2024 which provides guidelines updating the salary of Civilian Government Personnel including the Salary Adjustments of Local Government Units.
- 2. There are various PPAs and other items of expenditure which are needed to be integrated in the SAIP as supplements thereof and shall form part of Supplemental Budget No. 01-2025.
- 3. The corresponding programs of work were submitted.
- 4. The suggested additional budget allocation for MOOE under General Services of the Mayor's Office is P11,264,000.00. According to our CPDO, Ms. Chona Cepeda, the said budget is for the purpose of hiring additional 48 Job Orders. However, our HRMO, Ms. Ofelia Parallag has confirmed that these Job Orders have already been hired even without the corresponding budget allocation.

The following were the suggestions/recommendations raised:

- The funding for the additional forty-eight (48) Job Order workers under the MOOE of City Mayor's Office/CGSO could meantime be sourced out from the CY 2025 Annual Budget for Job Order Workers under Other General Services amounting to P57,800,000.00.
- 2. To utilize the city government's own heavy equipment in the procurement of inert soil in order to save money and reduce expenses for this purpose. Moreover, the purchase of inert soil should be included in the Annual Budget considering that is a necessary expense in the operation of the dumpsite and that garbage collection is done every day in the City.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

After thorough discussions and finding the subject CDC Resolutions to be in order and with merit and beneficial to Tuguegarao City Government and its constituents, the Committee of Whole favorably recommends the approval of the concomitant City Resolutions adopting and approving the following CDC Resolutions:
