CITY RESOLUTION NO. 100-09-2025

RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR, HON. MAILA ROSARIO S. TING-QUE, TO REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION TO THE COMMISSION ON ELECTIONS ON A NUMBER OF EXPENDITURES OF PUBLIC FUNDS PURSUANT TO COMELEC RESOLUTION NO. 11060

WHEREAS, the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) Central Office promulgated Resolution No. 11060 on the Rules and Regulations on the Prohibition Against the Release, Disbursement, or Expenditure of Public Funds for Social Services and Housing-Related Projects, and Issuance of Treasury Warrants and Similar Devices Under Sections 261 (V) and (w) of the Omnibus Election Code in Connection with the May 12, 2025 National and Local Elections, and BARMM Parliamentary Elections;

WHEREAS, Rule II of the same provides the Prohibition Against the Release, Disbursement, or Expenditure of Public Funds, and Issuance of Treasury Warrants and Similar Devices enumerating therein the prohibitions, exemptions and period of prohibition, from March 28, 2025 to May 12, 2025;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que, in her letter-request dated January 16, 2025 provided a list of Request for Exemption for Social Welfare and Services Projects;

WHEREAS, during the Committee Meeting of the Joint Committee on Social Services and Committee on Rules, Laws and Ethics, to which the matter was referred to, the list was checked to determine if there are items which can be exempted before or after the prohibition period;

WHEREAS, the joint committees, in consultation with the Office of the City Mayor, have decided to request exemption from the list submitted to the Ninth City Council on the following City Projects:

- 1. CAVRAA particularly the allowance of athletes and expenses for the live-out training
- 2. City counterpart for the drug rehabilitation of Persons Who Use Drugs at DOH-DATRC
- 3. Assistance to Youthful Offenders at CV-RRCY
- 4. Local Council for the Protection of Children (LCPC)
- 5. Assistance for Physical Restoration
- 6. Young Adults with Disabilities

- 7. Palarong Pambansa
- 8. Music and Arts Scholarship
- 9. Student's Financial Assistance Program
- 10. Scholarship and Student's Assistance Program
- 11. Science and Technology Scholarship
- 12. Bahayanihan Program for those ongoing projects whose materials stated in the Programs of Work were not purchased yet and definitely not for new projects
- 13. Honoraria of the Head of Office of the Senior Citizen Association and Coordinators
- 14. Character First Development Program
- 15. Alternative Learning System
- 16. Educational Assistance
- 17. Stimulation and Therapeutic Activity Center
- 18. City Nutrition Program
- 19. Mental Health Program

WHEREAS, there is a need for an authority to be granted to the Local Chief Executive to request for exemption through a City Council Resolution.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to grant authority to the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que, to request for exemption to the Commission on Elections on a number of expenditures of public funds pursuant to COMELEC Resolution No. 11060.
