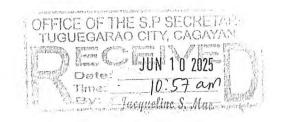

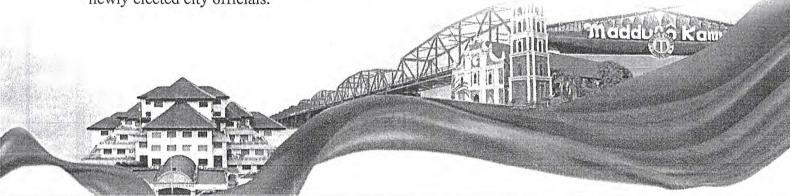
Herewith are the following City Development Council (CDC) resolutions for your information and appropriate action:

- 2. **CDC Resolution No. 09 series of 2025 -** A RESOLUTION ENDORSING TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD THE HEREIN SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (SAIP) NO. 1 CY 2025 FOR APPROPRIATE ACTION

In the interest of public welfare, this matter is certified as <u>URGENT</u> pursuant to Article 107 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Republic Act No. 7160, or the Local Government Code of 1991. We are also requesting the inclusion of these referrals in the agenda for the session of your august body on June 10, 2025.

If the aforesaid referrals will not be included in the agenda, by virtue of Section 52, paragraph b, of the Code, you are also notified to convene a SPECIAL SESSION on June 11, 2025 (Wednesday) to adopt the corresponding legislative action.

The Sangguniang Panlungsod is reminded to immediately act on the subject referrals, considering that if the same are delayed, the delivery of basic services will be further prejudiced since the preparation and approval of the development plans will be reinstituted and refiled by reason of the reorganization of both the City Council and the City Development Council, which is expected to last for 100 days after the assumption of the newly elected city officials.

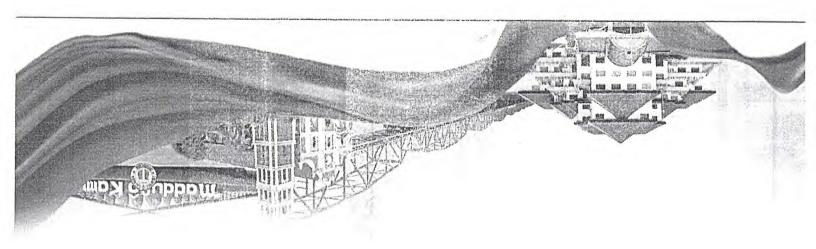

### CDC RESOLUTION NO. 08 Series of 2025

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND ENDORSING TO THE AUGUST SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD THE HEREIN SUPPLEMENTAL LOCAL DEVELOPMENT INVESTMENT PROGRAM (SLDIP) NO. IX CY 2023-2028 FOR APPROPRIATE ACTION

**WHEREAS,** Section 455 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the City Mayor shall direct the formulation of the city development plan, with the assistance of the city development council;

**WHEREAS**, the City Development Council, acting as a collegial body tasked by Republic Act No. 7160 and Republic Act No. 8755 to prepare and adopt the local development plans of the city, convened to submit the supplemental LDIP for the immediate action of the Sangguniang Panlungsod;

**WHEREAS,** during the said meeting, there were new programs, projects, and activities that are necessary and indispensable for the promotion of public welfare and were submitted for immediate consideration and action by the CDC;

**WHEREAS,** there is a need to integrate these priority projects in the LDIP as supplements thereof for the improvement of facilities and effectiveness of services of the Tuguegarao City government;

**NOW THEREFORE** on motion of Ms. Purita S. Licas from the Informers Club (I-club) Media Association, Inc., and duly seconded Ms. Elena Tuddao of Bagong Bayani ng Maharlika Movement, Inc., **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to **ADOPT** the herein attached Supplemental Local Development Investment Program No. IX CY 2023-2028 and **INDORSE** the same to the august Sangguniang Panlungsod for appropriate action.

#### CDC RESOLUTION NO. 09 Series of 2025

### A RESOLUTION ENDORSING TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD THE HEREIN SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (SAIP) NO. 1 CY 2025 FOR APPROPRIATE ACTION

**WHEREAS**, the City Development Council (CDC) Resolution No. 07 series of 2025, which contains the programs, projects, and activities in the Supplemental Annual Investment Program, was endorsed by the Office of the City Mayor to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for its appropriate action on March 10, 2025;

**WHEREAS**, after numerous committee meetings and plenary discussion, the Sangguniang Panlungsod substantially reduced the amount of several programs, projects, and activities in the said Supplemental Annual Investment Program by virtue of City Resolution No. 205-09-2025, to wit:

**WHEREAS**, a plain review of the City Council Resolution reveals that the Sangguniang Panlungsod failed to clearly and convincingly state the grounds for the substantial reduction of the amount specified in the Supplemental Annual Investment Program adopted by the City Development Council;

**WHEREAS**, the action of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of reducing the amount specified in the Supplemental Annual Investment Program without referring the matter to the City Development Council not only circumvents but also violates the well-established rule, recognized by the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM), that the formulation and initiation of local development plans are the statutory mandate of the local development councils;

**WHEREAS,** the DILG, through Legal Opinion No. 22 series of 2007, categorically and unequivocally reminded the Local Government Units that although the Sanggunian is authorized by Republic Act No. 7160 to approve the local development plan formulated by the local development council, such authority **DOES NOT** include the power to modify, revise, or alter

**WHEREAS,** aside from being inconsistent with statutory and regulatory guidelines and blatantly disregarding the same, the action of the Sanggunian has derailed the approval the Supplemental Annual Investment Program, which resulted in the unreasonable delay of funding the vital and necessary programs, projects, and activities for the general welfare of the Tuguegaraoenos;

**WHEREAS**, the failure or inability of the Sangguniang Panlungsod to approve the necessary funding for the Sanitary Landfill, particularly the procurement of inert soil, may give rise to the accountability of the City Government for non-compliance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 9003 and other relevant laws;

**WHEREAS,** given the limited time of the incumbent City Council and City Development Council, whose terms are both going to expire on June 30, 2025, and the subsequent reorganization of the local special bodies within 100 days from the assumption of the newly elected city officials, there is a necessity for the Sangguniang Panlungsod to immediately review, discuss, deliberate, and approve the Supplemental Annual Investment Program (SAIP) so as not to hamper the delivery of basic and vital services;

**WHEREAS**, notwithstanding its opposition to the irregular and unreasonable actions of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, the City Development Council, with due acknowledgment of the pressing need to have additional development measures for the benefit of its constituency, reconvened on June 9, 2025, to immediately adopt and indorse the Supplemental Annual Investment Program, generally described as follows:

- The Personnel Services of the Tuguegarao City Government is a major component of the Supplemental Annual Investment Program (SAIP) by virtue of the Executive Order No. 64, Section 04 dated August 02, 2024, which provides guidelines updating the Salary of Civilian Government Personnel including the Salary Adjustment of Local Government Units (LGUs);
- ii. The SAIP embodies various priority programs, projects and activities and other items of expenditure that are necessary for public service, general welfare, and public convenience, including the upgrading, repair, and maintenance of public facilities and equipment and the implementation of environmental management (Inert Soil) project.

WHEREAS, the Local Finance Committee certified that the amount of One Hundred Forty-Seven Million Thirty-Three Thousand One Hundred Ten Pesos (PhP 147,033,110.00) from unappropriated surplus (retained earnings), savings from continuing appropriation, and appropriation from reprogrammed projects for 2025 is free from any obligation and is available for appropriation;

**WHEREAS,** there is therefore a need to integrate these priority PPAs and other items of expenditure in the Supplemental Annual Investment Program (SAIP) AS SUPPLEMENTS THEREOF and form part of the Supplemental Budget No. 01 CY 2025;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Ms. Elena Tuddao, President of Bagong Bayani ng Maharlika Movement, Inc., and duly seconded by all members, **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to **ADOPT** the herein attached Supplemental Annual Investment Program (SAIP) No. 01 CY 2025 and **INDORSE** the same to the august Sangguniang Panlungsod for appropriate action.

**RESOLVED FUTHER**, that all CDC resolutions contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.
