## RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CHANGE OF PROJECT TITLE/REPROGRAMMING THE VARIOUS CANCELLED OBLIGATIONS ON DISCONTINUED INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT FOR OTHER PRIORITY INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT FOR INCORPORATION IN THE SUPPLEMENTAL LOCAL DEVELOPMENT INVESTMENT PROGRAM (SLDIP) NO. VII CY 2023-2028 AND SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (SAIP) NO. 2 CY 2024

WHEREAS, under Section 16 of Republic Act. No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that "Every Local Government Unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, Section 23 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides among other things that "the local chief executive may, upon authority of the Sanggunian, negotiate and secure financial grants or donations in kind, in support of the basic services or facilities enumerated under Section 17 hereof, from local and foreign assistance agencies without necessity of securing clearance or approval therefor from any department agency, or office of the national government or from any higher local government unit;"

WHEREAS, the Ninth City Council approved in its 118<sup>th</sup> Regular Session City Resolution No. 626-09-2024 adopting and approving CDC Resolution No. 9-2024 titled "City Development Council Resolution Reprogramming the Various Cancelled Obligations on Discontinued Infrastructure Projects for Other Priority Infrastructure Projects for Incorporation in the Supplemental Local Development Investment Program (SLDIP) No. VII CY 2023-2028 and Supplemental Annual Investment Program (SAIP) No. 2 CY 2024 and Endorsing the Same to the August Sangguniang Panlungsod;"
