The Joint-Committees met and deliberated on the referral:

COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 137-2024

SUBJECT:

***“Indorsement of the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que, on the request for the temporary closure of Gomez to Gonzaga and Del Rosario Streets for twenty (20) days upon approval, for the installation of metal roofing and other construction works along Tuguegarao City Commercial Center.”***

ACTION TAKEN:

The members of the committee met to discuss the subject matter with the presence of the resource persons.

FINDINGS:

- 1.) The City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que, indorsed a letter dated April 18, 2024, informing the City Council that there will be an installation of metal roofing and other construction works at the Tuguegarao City Commercial Center.
- 2.) The City Mayor requested for the temporary closure of Gomez to Gonzaga and Del Rosario Streets for twenty (20) days upon approval.
- 3.) The said construction consists of eight (8) days production followed by twelve (12) days curving and lifting of the metal roofing.

*Adopted during the 87th pl - 4/30/2024*

- 4.) There is a need to declare the temporary full closure of the said road to pave way for the 12-day curving and lifting of the metal roofing of the Tuguegarao City Commercial Center to ensure the safety of passers and vehicles in the area.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Finding the request to be in order and with merit, the committee favorably recommends for the passage of an Ordinance Declaring the Temporary Road Closure of Del Rosario Street (from Gomez to Gonzaga Streets) to Pave Way for the Curving and Lifting of Metal Roofing at Tuguegarao City Commercial Center for a Period of Twelve (12) days, starting from May 3, 2024 to May 14, 2024. The committee further recommends the following:

- 1.) For the PSSU/TMG to assign additional personnel to manage the flow of traffic in the area.
- 2.) Installation of signages and early warning devices before the affected area.
- 3.) Information dissemination about the subject road closure.
- 4.) PSSU/TMG to devise alternate routes and assist in the traffic and safety.
- 5.) For deployment of a standby rescue team within the area.

CITY ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

**CITY ORDINANCE DECLARING THE TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF DEL ROSARIO STREET (FROM GOMEZ TO GONZAGA STREETS) TO PAVE WAY FOR THE CURVING AND LIFTING OF METAL ROOFING AT TUGUEGARAO CITY COMMERCIAL CENTER FOR A PERIOD OF TWELVE (12) DAYS, STARTING FROM MAY 3, 2024 TO MAY 14, 2024**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the pertinent provisions of Section 21 of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Local Government Unit of Tuguegarao is authorized to temporarily close some of the local roads falling within its jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS**, there is an ongoing installation of roofing and other construction works at the Tuguegarao City Commercial Center;

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the City Mayor requested for the temporary closure of a portion of Del Rosario Street specifically from Gomez Street to Gonzaga Street;

**WHEREAS**, to ensure the safety of the passers and vehicles along the said street, there is a need for the temporary road closure of the said street to pave way for the curing and lifting stage of the said project for a period of twelve (12) days, starting from May 3, 2024 to May 14, 2024.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it **ORDAINED** by the Ninth City Council of Tuguegarao in session assembled, to enact:

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as "City Ordinance Declaring the Temporary Road Closure of Del Rosario Street (from Gomez to Gonzaga Streets) to Pave Way for the Curving and Lifting of Metal Roofing at Tuguegarao City Commercial Center for a Period of Twelve (12) days, starting from May 3, 2024 to May 14, 2024."

**SECTION 2. SCOPE AND LIMITATION.** This Ordinance shall cover Del Rosario Street, specifically from Gomez Street to Gonzaga Street as subject for closure to pave way for the curing and lifting of the metal roofing of the Tuguegarao City Commercial Center.

**SECTION 3. INFORMATION.** This Ordinance shall be disseminated through signages and by the City Information Office, all mass media outlets, and the affected barangay.

**SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTATION.** The implementing agency shall be the Public Safety and Security Unit (PSSU), Traffic Management Group in coordination with the affected barangay along TCCC. Installation of signages and early warning devices shall be made before the said project.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect on May 3, 2024 until May 14, 2024.
