SUBJECT:

"Indorsement of the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que, on Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cagayan Resolution No. 2025-11-322 Lifting the State of Calamity in the Province of Cagayan Due to Typhoon Julian, as Recommended by the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council"

ACTION TAKEN:

The members of the committee met to discuss the subject matter with the presence of the resource person/s.

FINDINGS:

- 1. The Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cagayan passed Resolution No. 2025-11-322 entitled "Resolution Lifting the State of Calamity in the Province of Cagayan due to Typhoon Julian, as recommended by the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council."
- 2. The Sangguniang Panlungsod has adopted a separate resolution placing Tuguegarao City under a state of calamity by virtue of City Resolution No. 601-09-2024, but the same is for "Typhoon Kristine."
- 3. The CSWDO said all relief goods and appropriate assistance had been delivered to all intended beneficiaries during the period of the effectivity of the state of calamity.

RECOMMENDATION:

Considering that the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cagayan has already declared the lifting of the state of calamity due to the effects of Typhoon Julian in the whole Province of Cagayan, the subject matter has been rendered moot and academic.
