CITY RESOLUTION NO. 156-10-2025

**RESOLUTION APPROVING AND GRANTING THE ACCREDITATION OF
VARIOUS CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT
UNIT OF TUGUEGARAO CITY**

WHEREAS, Section 34, Book 1, Chapter IV of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160) mandates local government units to promote the establishment and operation of people's and non-governmental organizations to serve as active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued Memorandum Circular No. 2025-060 on June 23, 2025 providing the comprehensive guidelines on the accreditation of Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) and the selection of their representatives to Local Special Bodies;

WHEREAS, eight (8) Civil Society Organizations applicants have formally expressed their intent to be accredited with the Local Government Unit of Tuguegarao City to foster an active partnership with the City Government in advancing local governance and nation-building;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod has thoroughly reviewed the applications of these organizations and found that they have satisfactorily complied with all the documentary requirements and criteria for accreditation as stipulated in DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2025-060;

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVE, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to approve and grant the accreditation of the following Civil Society Organizations:

2. Cagayan Valley Kalinga Apayao Transport Cooperative
3. Tuguegarao Agri-Based Multipurpose Cooperative
4. Cagayan Valley Raisers Agriculture Cooperative

8. Tuguegarao City Women's Club Inc.


RESOLVED FURTHER, that this accreditation shall be valid for a term of three years, until June 30, 2028, unless earlier revoked for a valid cause.


On motion of Hon. Baccay and without any objection, **CITY RESOLUTION NO. 156-10-2025** was **APPROVED** under suspended rules.
