SUBJECT:

Indorsement of the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que, requesting for an authority to represent, enter and sign for and on behalf of the City Local Government Unit of Tuguegarao the Memorandum of Agreement with Saint Paul Hospital of Tuguegarao regarding the Residency Training Program.

FINDINGS:

1. Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que indorsed to the Ninth City Council indorsed the request for an authority to represent, enter and sign for and on behalf of the City Local Government Unit of Tuguegarao the Memorandum of Agreement with Saint Paul Hospital of Tuguegarao regarding the Residency Training Program.

3. The resident doctors will conduct community health research, create disease prevention and/or health promotion programs specifically to the community and participate in the


implementation of health and advocacy programs of the Department of Health, Local Government Unit and St. Paul Hospital Tuguegarao, Inc.

4. Patients from Barangay Linao East who are classified as service patients by the social worker can avail the following:
 - a. Discounted of basic laboratory and imaging studies for admitted and out-patient consultations;
 - b. Discounted room rates for admitted patients; and
 - c. Waived professional fees for admitted patients.


RECOMMENDATION:



**DRAFT RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA)
BETWEEN THE TUGUEGARAO CITY GOVERNMENT AND SAINT PAUL HOSPITAL OF
TUGUEGARAO CITY RELATIVE TO ITS RESIDENCY TRAINING PROGRAM AND GRANTING
AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR, HON. MAILA ROSARIO S. TING-QUE, TO SIGN FOR AND
ON BEHALF OF THE TUGUEGARAO CITY GOVERNMENT THE SAID OF MOA**

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 2382 also known as The Medical Act of 1959, governs the practice of medicine in the Philippines and includes provisions related to the training and certification of medical professionals and mandates also the establishment of training programs to ensure the competence and professional development of medical practitioners;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7722 also known as Higher Education Act of 1994, regulates higher education institutions and ensures the quality of their programs, including those related to postgraduate medical education and ensures that residency programs contribute effectively to the professional growth of medical graduates;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health (DOH) plays a crucial role in the accreditation and regulation of hospitals and medical institutions that offer residency training programs of which it ensures that these institutions provide adequate facilities, training, and supervision for medical residents through its Hospital Accreditation Commission;

WHEREAS, Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth), through various circulars and guidelines, supports residency training programs by providing financial mechanisms that help subsidize the training of medical residents;

WHEREAS, the *“Indorsement of the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que, requesting for an authority to represent, enter and sign for and on behalf of the City Local Government Unit of Tuguegarao the Memorandum of Agreement with Saint Paul Hospital of Tuguegarao regarding the Residency Training Program”* was jointly referred to the Committee on Health and Sanitation and Committee on Education for proper action;

WHEREAS, the joint committee, Committee on Health and Sanitation together with the Committee on Education met on April 25, 2024 to discuss the subject referral with the presence of resource persons;

WHEREAS, St. Paul Hospital of Tuguegarao, Inc. has offered medical community services to be rendered by its resident Physicians to patients from Linao East, Tuguegarao City through the City Health Office;

WHEREAS, Patients from Barangay Linao East who are classified as service patients by the social worker can avail the following:

- a) Discounted of basic laboratory and imaging studies for admitted and outpatient consultations;
- b) Discounted room rates for admitted patients; and
- c) Waived professional fees for admitted patients.;

WHEREAS, there is a need for the passage of a resolution granting authority to the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que, to sign for and on behalf of the Tuguegarao City Government the said MOA;

WHEREAS, upon evaluation of the subject referral, the Committees recommended for the approval of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) and the granting of authority to the City Mayor to sign for and on behalf of the Tuguegarao City Government the said MOA.

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVE, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to approve of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Tuguegarao City Government and Saint Paul Hospital of Tuguegarao, Inc. regarding its Residency Training Program and authorizing the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que to sign for and on behalf of the Tuguegarao City Government the said MOA.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution to St. Paul Hospital of Tuguegarao City, City Health Office and Barangay Linao East, Tuguegarao City for information and proper action.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This AGREEMENT was made and executed by and between:

ST. PAUL HOSPITAL OF TUGUEGARAO, INC, a non-stock and non-profit corporation organized under and by laws of the Republic of the Philippines with office address at Luna Extension, Ugac Norte, Tuguegarao City, through its **Department of Internal Medicine**, represented by **SR. ADELINA B. JAVELLANA, SPC.** hereinafter referred to as the "The First Party";

- and -

CITY GOVERNMENT OF TUGUEGARAO is a local government unit created in accordance with the Local Government Code and the City Charter of Tuguegarao, principal office at with postal address at Office of the City Mayor New City Hall Compound - Enrile Boulevard, Carig Sur, Tuguegarao City, Cagayan, and represented by **HON. MAYOR MAILA ROSARIO TING-QUE**, hereinafter referred to as the "The Second Party";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the First Party has offered medical community services to be rendered by its residents Physicians to patients from Brgy. Linao East, Tuguegarao City. The Second Party agrees to accommodate the services offered by the FIRST PARTY subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter stipulated.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein agreed upon, the FIRST PARTY and the SECOND PARTY, by these presents, have entered, as they hereby enter, into a Memorandum of Agreement, under the following terms and conditions:



SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY THR FIRST PARTY

1. The community rotation will be as follows;
 - a. Once-a-week rotation of the 3rd year residents in Internal Medicine where they manage adult diseases.
 - b. 4-hour adult (patients >18 years old) ambulatory care clinic every Wednesday from 1 pm to 5 pm.
2. The resident Doctors will conduct community health research;
3. The resident Doctors will create disease prevention and/or health promotion programs specific to the community;
4. The resident Doctors can participate in the implementation of health and advocacy programs of DOH/LGU/PCP/SPHT; and
5. The resident Doctors can have access to the TB clinic.

BENEFITS TO COMMUNITY PATIENTS

6. Patients from Brgy. Linao East who are classified as service patients by the social worker can avail of the following:
 - a. Discounted price of basic laboratory and imaging studies for admitted and out-patient consultations;
 - b. Discounted room rates for admitted patients; and
 - c. Waived professional fees for admitted patients.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SECOND PARTY

7. The Brgy. Healthcare workers shall be responsible for the triaging of patients, record keeping and scheduling of patients appointment.
8. The city health office shall provide the medicines and diagnostic tests.

9. This agreement is for three years which shall commence on _____ and end on _____. But it may be renewed upon the agreement of the parties.


MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION

10. Any violation of the terms and conditions of this contract by the parties shall give the other party the option to rescind or cancel immediately the contract without the necessity of judicial proceedings.
11. The First Party reserves the right to terminate this Agreement without need of cause or reason upon thirty-day written notice to the Second Party.
12. This agreement may be modified by subsequent agreement of the parties only by an instrument in writing signed by both of them or an oral agreement to the extent that the parties carry it out.
