CITY RESOLUTION NO. 165-09-2025

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE TUGUEGARAO CITY GOVERNMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT RELATIVE TO THE SOCIAL PENSION FOR INDIGENT SENIOR CITIZENS PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. MAILA ROSARIO S. TING-QUE, TO SIGN FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE TUGUEGARAO CITY GOVERNMENT THE SAID MOA

WHEREAS, Chapter II, Section 17(b)(2)(iv) of the Local Government Code of the Philippines (Republic Act No. 7160) mandates the Municipality/City to provide Social Welfare Services which include programs and projects on child and youth welfare, family and community welfare, women's welfare, welfare of the elderly and disabled persons; community based rehabilitation programs for vagrants, beggars, street children, scavengers, juvenile delinquents and victims of drug abuse; livelihood and other pro-poor projects, nutrition services and family planning services;

WHEREAS, Section 2(h)(1) of Republic Act No. 11916 or "An Act Increasing the Social Pension of Indigent Senior Citizens and Appropriating Funds Therefore, Amending for the Purpose Republic Act No. 7432", indigent senior citizens shall be entitled to a monthly stipend amount to not less than One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) to augment their daily subsistence and other medical needs;

WHEREAS, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) is the primary government agency mandated to develop, administer and implement comprehensive social welfare and protection programs and poverty-reduction solutions designed to uplift the living conditions and empower the poor, vulnerable and disadvantaged children, youth, women, older persons, persons with disabilities, families or persons in crisis or at-risk, and communities needing assistance through programs and services implementation with or through Local Government Units (LGUs), People's Organizations (POs), Government Organizations (GOs) and other members of the civic society;

WHEREAS, the DSWD as the lead agency in social welfare and development has implemented the Social Pension for Indigent Senior Citizens (SPISC) since 2011 through DSWD Field Offices (FOs) in all regions;

WHEREAS, the Tuguegarao City Government recognizes the importance of supporting its indigent senior citizens through this program and seeks to strengthen its collaboration with the DSWD for the effective and efficient implementation of the social pension distribution;

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Tuguegarao City Government and the DSWD establishes the terms of partnership, roles and responsibilities to ensure the successful implementation of the Social Pension for Indigent Senior Citizens Program within the city;

WHEREAS, there is a need to authorize the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que, to sign the MOU for and on behalf of the Tuguegarao City Government to formalize and facilitate the implementation of the program.


