RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. MAILA ROSARIO S. TING-QUE, TO SIGN FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE TUGUEGARAO CITY GOVERNMENT THE CONTRACT OF LEASE FOR THE TUGUEGARAO CITY COMMERCIAL CENTER WITH STALL LESSEES

WHEREAS, Section 22(c) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, grants the power to the Local Chief Executive to enter into contracts on behalf of the local government unit with prior authorization by the Sanggunian concerned;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the above-stated provision, the Tuguegarao City Government is allowed to enter into a contract of lease with private and public entities for the use of its facilities to fulfill its mandate to raise revenues to support its programs, projects and activities;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that any local government unit is vested with the power to prescribe and collect fees as well as provide penalties and surcharges for the general welfare of the inhabitants therein subject to the limitations imposed by law;

WHEREAS, the Tuguegarao City Commercial Center is primarily established to provide a venue for the trade of goods and services, and remains a vital economic hub for residents and neighboring municipalities;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of City Ordinance No. 43-08-2022 states that the Contract of Lease for stalls shall be for a period of five (5) years renewable upon its expiration upon mutual consent of the Lessor (City Government) and the Lessee, unless revoked in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance;
