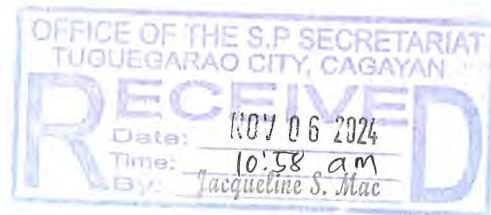

Council Resolution No. 03, Series of 2024

**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE DECLARATION OF TUGUEGARAO CITY
UNDER THE STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO SEVERE TROPICAL STORM
“KRISTINE”**

WHEREAS, Republic Act 10121 otherwise known as “Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010”, to uplift the morale of disaster victims and hasten the return of normalcy in disaster-stricken areas, the entire resources of both national and local government should be mobilized and utilized to the maximum extent. Relief and rehabilitation efforts should likewise be facilitated with the full participation of all concerned sectors of society;

WHEREAS, under Section 1(m), Rule 2 of IRR of R.A No. 10121, the provision of emergency assistance during or immediately after a disaster in order to save lives, reduce health impacts, ensure public safety and meet the basic subsistence needs of the people affected. Disaster response is predominantly focused on immediate and short-term needs and sometimes called “disaster relief”;

WHEREAS, under the NDRRMC Memorandum Order No. 60, s. 2019, Revised Guidelines for the declaration of a state of calamity stating that a City, Municipality, Province or Region may be declared under a State of Calamity when any of the following conditions brought about by natural and /or human-induced disasters are present.

WHEREAS, Tuguegarao City was devastated by Severe Tropical Storm “Kristine”, displacing a total of Fifty-Three Thousand Seven Hundred Three (53,703) individuals equivalent to thirty-two point twenty-eight percent 32.28% of the total population of One Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Four (166,334);

WHEREAS, the said typhoon also caused severe damage to agriculture sector itemized as follows, to wit;

- a. Three Million One Hundred Seventy-Nine Two Hundred Eighty Pesos (₱ 3,179,280) worth of damages in cereals with total of Three Hundred Ninety-Three Farmers (393) affected;
- b. Six Million One Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand One Hundred Twelve Pesos and Sixty Centavo (₱ 6,174,112.60) in Corn with total of Two Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Six Farmer (2,386) affected; and
- c. Eight Hundred Fourty Six Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Pesos (₱ 846,350.00) in High Value Commercial Crops with total of One Hundred Thirty-Seven Farmers (137) Affected.

WHEREAS, the total damages in agriculture sector is amounting to Ten Million One Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-two peso and Sixty Pesos (₱ 10,199,742.60);

WHEREAS, the provision of essential farm inputs, such as seeds, fertilizers, and equipment, will enable these farmers to rebuild their operations and ensure food security in the community; and

WHEREAS, facilitating access to these resources will not only aid in the recovery of the agricultural sector but also promote resilience against future natural disasters;

WHEREAS, due to the paramount importance of ensuring and preserving the safety of the city’s constituency’s life, limb and property before, during and after any disaster or calamity, and based on the damage assessment and evaluation of the CDRRM Council, there is an urgent need to recommend the declaration of Tuguegarao City under a state of calamity together with the appropriate disaster mitigation measures without prejudice to any City Ordinance that the 9th City Council may promulgate pursuant to R.A. No. 10121;

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing considerations, the CDRRM Council as a collegial body, in quorum, **RESOLVES** to **APPROVE** the resolution recommending Tuguegarao City under the state of calamity to the 9th City Council for their proper consideration and appropriate action.

On the joint motion of the members present during the emergency meeting on this CDRRM Council **RESOLUTION** is hereby **APPROVED**.
