SUBJECT:

FINDINGS:

1. Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que indorsed to the Ninth City Council, requesting for an authority to represent, enter and sign for and on behalf of the Tuguegarao City Government the draft Memorandum of Agreement with Cagayan State University relative to the practicum of identified students.
2. Cagayan State University has requested for an on-the-job training of their student in Bachelor of Science in Agricultural and Biosystems in the name of Mr. Fernando F. Calabazon IV who will be deployed at the City Agriculture Office and will render 160 hours on-the-job training.
3. The On-the-Job training of the said student will start after the approval of the said Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) by the Ninth City Council.

4. Committee Report No. 219-2024 relative to the subject Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) was calendared last Regular Session held on August 13, 2024. The said Committee Report was deferred due to lacking document.

5. Cagayan State University – Carig Campus retracted their request for the on-the-job training of their student because of some reasons stated in their letter dated August 14, 2024. Considering the above premises, it is already moot and academic for the Committee to act on said indorsement.


