SUBJECT:

Endorsement of the City Administrator, Mr. Juanito A. Calubaquib, and the City Planning & Development Officer, Ms. Chona Q. Sedano, EnP., on the applications for accreditation of various Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) as members of the local special bodies of Tuguegarao City.

FOR THE PRESIDING OFFICER:

The members of the Committee convened to discuss and deliberate on the endorsement of the City Administrator, Mr. Juanito A. Calubaquib, and the City Planning & Development Officer, Ms. Chona Q. Sedano, EnP., concerning the applications for accreditation of various Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), for appropriate action.

The Committee respectfully submits this report to the esteemed body in session, outlining the actions taken, findings, and recommendations.

ACTIONS TAKEN:

The Committee conducted a detailed evaluation of the requirements submitted by the various CSO applicants for accreditation, with the assistance of the abovementioned resource persons.

FINDINGS:

Forty-seven (47) Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) applied for accreditation as members
of the local special bodies of Tuguegarao City. Some CSO's applications were renewals for
accreditation, while others were new applications.

- 2. The Committee carefully evaluated the documents and requirements submitted in support of their applications. Upon evaluation, it was noted that:
 - a) Most of the applicants submitted complete requirements per DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2025-060 dated June 23, 2025, Section 4.2.2. Some requirements, however were not duly notarized as indicated in the DILG MC, while other documents were unsigned.
 - b) A few applicants did not meet the minimum one-year operational existence requirement per Section 4.3.1.
 - c) Some annexes were combined or fused with others, instead of being submitted separately;
 - d) Some applicants had missing requirements essential for accreditation per Section 4.3.1 of the said memorandum.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

After a thorough review of all the applications for accreditation, the Committee unanimously recommends the adoption and passage of a City Resolution approving the accreditation of the following CSOs for membership in the Local Special Bodies (LSB);

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND GRANTING THE ACCREDITATION OF VARIOUS CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF TUGUEGARAO CITY

WHEREAS, Section 34, Book I, Chapter IV of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160) mandates local government units to promote the establishment and operation of people's and non-governmental organizations to serve as active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued Memorandum Circular No. 2025-060 on June 23, 2025, providing the comprehensive guidelines on the accreditation of Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) and the selection of their representatives to Local Special Bodies;

WHEREAS, a total of forty-seven (47) Civil Society Organizations applicants has formally expressed their intent to be accredited with the Local Government Unit of Tuguegarao City to foster an active partnership with the City Government in advancing local governance and nationbuilding;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod has thoroughly reviewed the applications of these organizations and found that they have satisfactorily complied with all the documentary requirements and criteria for accreditation as stipulated in DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2025-060:
