DRAFT RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA)
BETWEEN THE TUGUEGARAO CITY GOVERNMENT AND THE CHRONICLES
INSTITUTE OF ISABELA, INC. RELATIVE TO THE ON-THE-JOB TRAINING OF ITS
CAREGIVING NC II STUDENTS AND GRANTING AUTHORITY TOTHE CITY
MAYOR, HON. MAILA ROSARIO S. TING-QUE, TO SIGN FOR AND ONBEHALF OF
THE TUGUEGARAO CITY GOVERNMENT THE SAID MOA

WHEREAS, Section 455(b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, grants the Local Chief Executive the power to enter into contracts for and on behalf of the local government unit upon prior authorization by the Sangguniang Panlungsod;

WHEREAS, in support to the endeavors of students studying in any school or university in Tuguegarao City, the Tuguegarao City Government allows students to undergo actual office experience in its different offices, thereby helping them put to practice their learnings in school;

WHEREAS, the Chronicles Institute of Isabela, Inc. has requested the Tuguegarao City Government for the On-the-Job Training of its Caregiving NC II students as part of their curriculum;

WHEREAS, it is necessary for Chronicles Institute of Isabela, Inc. to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Tuguegarao City Government to make the MOA legally binding;

WHEREAS, the affiliation fee to be paid by the school shall be included in the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) and will be collected by the City Treasurer's Office and will accrue to the General fund;

WHEREAS, there shall thirty (30) students who shall undergo 240 hours On-the-Job Training and will be deployed at the Tuguegarao City People's General Hospital (TCPGH);

WHEREAS, the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que indorsed to the Tenth City Council the above-stated MOA and requested for an authority to sign for and on behalf of the Tuguegarao City Government the said MOA;

WHEREAS, after a deliberation in a committee meeting held for the said purpose, the Committee on Education found the request to be in order and beneficial to the concerned students;

WHEREAS, after the approval of the concomitant committee report, the Tenth City Council during their 12th Regular Session held on September 23, 2025 deemed it proper and necessary to approve the herein resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVE as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to approve the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Tuguegarao City Government and the Chronicles Institute of Isabela, Inc. relative to the On-the-Job Training of its Caregiving NC II students and granting authority to the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que, to sign for and on behalf of the Tuguegarao City Government the said MOA.

VILLACETE (hereinafter referred to as the "SECOND PARTY").

-WITHNESSETH-

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY, is a TECHNICAL EDUCATION SKILLS AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY accredited training provider whose mission is to provide and assist all aspiring caregivers to achieve the desired knowledge, training, and exercise in a learning environment where a complete, adequate and integrated system of learning is observed through delivery of quality TVET to meet the requirements of local or global manpower.

WHEREAS, SECOND PARTY, has a registered Training Program in Health Social & Community Services Sector cover competencies in CAREGIVING NC II;

WHEREAS, CHRONICLES INSTITUTE OF ISABELA, INC. and TUGUEGARAO CITY GOVERNMENT agree among themselves.

- 1. That the FIRST PARTY shall provide adequate facilities, supplies and equipment as well as maximum opportunity for the student-trainee to gain quality and effective caregiving competencies and learning experiences.

- 3. That the SECOND PARTY shall deploy qualified Student-Trainee in their chosen hospital and provide certified list of Student-Trainees qualified to undergo Clinical Placement and the Clinical Instructor with their respective schedules.
- 4. The Student-Trainee and the SECOND PARTY, coordinator shall abide to the hospital's rules and regulations and comply with those impose for the program; otherwise, they shall be excluded from further participation.
