SUBJECT:

Endorsement of the Memorandum of Agreement with the Medical Colleges of Northern Philippines (MCNP) for Nursing Related Learning Experience (RLE).

FOR THE PRESIDING OFFICER:

The Committee convened to discuss and deliberate on the endorsement by City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que, of the draft Memorandum of Agreement (MOA). The MOA is between the Tuguegarao City Government and the Medical Colleges of Northern Philippines (MCNP) and concerns the Related Learning Experience (RLE) or practicum for its College of Nursing students.

The Committee respectfully submits this **Committee Report** and has the honor to present before this august body the following **actions taken, findings, and recommendations**:

ACTIONS TAKEN:

The Committee conducted a thorough evaluation of the City Mayor's endorsement regarding the draft MOA with MCNP concerning the nursing students' Related Learning Experience (RLE) or practicum.

FINDINGS:

- The MCNP College of Nursing has partnered with the Tuguegarao City Government for more than ten (10) years through a MOA, which was most recently renewed yesterday.
- 2. The partnership, involving MCNP, the Tuguegarao City People's General Hospital (TCPGH), the City Health Office (CHO), and the Barangay Health Stations, is guided by Joint Administrative Order No. 2013-0034 of the Department of Health (DOH) and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED). This Order governs the affiliation and training of students in hospitals and rural health units, and any violation of its provisions shall constitute valid grounds for the MOA's cancellation.

- MCNP's curricular offering is highly beneficial to the populace, as it provides local access
 to nursing education, thereby sparing students the inconvenience and additional expenses
 of pursuing the course outside Tuguegarao City.
- 4. The Medical Colleges of Northern Philippines specifically sought the inclusion of Barangay Health Stations in the MOA to augment primary health services in the barangays.
- 5. The Committee **concurred with the institution's request** to extend the duration of the Memorandum of Agreement from one (1) year to **three (3) years**.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

After a careful review of the Memorandum of Agreement, particularly the roles and responsibilities of the concerned parties, the Committee finds the MOA to be in order, **meritorious**, and beneficial to the Tuguegarao City Government and its constituents. Accordingly, the Committee favorably recommends its approval, subject to the following suggestions and amendments:

- 1. Change the duration of the Memorandum of Agreement from one (1) year to three (3) years.
- 2. Include an additional whereas clause covering the specific participation of Barangay Health Stations in the MOA.
- 3. Include the Chairman of the Committee on Health as one of the witnesses and signatories to the MOA.
- 4. Require MCNP to submit to the City Council the names of old and new students who will undergo the Related Learning Experience (RLE) or practicum.
- 5. Require that all fees be paid to the City Treasurer's Office, subject to future increases in accordance with Department of Health (DOH) guidelines.

Finally, the Committee recommends the passage of a resolution granting authority to the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que to sign the Memorandum of Agreement on behalf of the Tuguegarao City Government and the Medical Colleges of Northern Philippines (MCNP).

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between:

The LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF TUGUEGARAO, an institution created and existing by the virtue of the Philippine Laws with principal office address at TUGUEGARAO CITY, CAGAYAN represented by Hon. MATLA ROSARIO S. TING-QUE herein referred to as the "PGH-TUGUEGARAO, CHO-Tuguegarao and Barangay Health Stations" as the First Party.

and -

The MEDICAL COLLEGES OF NORTHERN PHILIPPINES, a private educational institution duly registered and existing under the laws of the Philippines, with campus and principal address at Alimannao Hills, Peñablanca, Cagayan represented by its President, CHRISTIAN R. GUZMAN, Ph.D and herein referred to as "MCNP" as the Second Party.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the PARTNERSHIP is guided by the Policies, Procedures and Guidelines of the Department of Health governing affiliation and training of students in Hospitals/Rural Health Units and other health agencies and that PGH-TUGUEGARAO, CHO-Yuguegarao and Barangay Health Stations shall be responsible and liable to the fullest extent for any violation of the provisions of the DOH-CHED Joint AO No. 2013-0034 entitled "Policies and Guidelines on the Affiliation of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) with Hospitals and other Health Facilities for the Training of students in Health Professional Education. Likewise, MCNP shall strictly comply with the provisions for above Administrative Order and any violation thereof shall be legitimate ground for cancellation of this MEMOKANDUM OF AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the curricular offering of <u>MCNP-COLLEGE OF NURSING</u> is greatly beneficial to the people as it has made accessible such course to students who wish to enroll therein, thus sparing them of the inconvenience and additional expenses of taking this course outside Tuguegarao City.

WHEREAS, quality education and health services are the primary concerns of government thus any undertaking calculated to enhance the promotion thereof in consortium with the private entity should be encouraged and supported.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed that:

LGU-TUGUEGARAO shall be responsible on the following:

- Allow MCNP Nursing affiliates undergoing Related Learning Experience (RLE) or Practicum, to have free use of the facilities, equipment, apparatuses and other paraphernalia of the <u>PGH-TUGUEGARAO</u>, <u>CHO-Tuguegarao and Barangay Health Stations</u>, provided that their use shall be properly authorized and supervised by the staff of the <u>PGH-TUGUEGARAO</u>, <u>CHO-Tuguegarao and Barangay Health Stations</u>;
- Provide a conference area as a venue for all pre and post-conferences during the duration of the community exposure;
- 3. Encourage its heads, staff members and personnel deployed at <u>PGH-TUGUEGARAO</u>, CHO-Tuguegarao and Barangay Health Stations to lend their assistance to the MCND student officials.

4. Shall only allow student affiliates to rotate in the Non-Covid Areas;

MCNP-College of Nursing shall be responsible on the following:

- MCNP shall submit official list of Community Affiliation matrix of schedule with list of students and Community Health Nurse preceptors;
- MCNP shall be directly and primarily responsible for the education, training and safety and take full responsibility of its own students taking their community exposure in <u>PGH-TUGUEGARAO</u>, <u>CHO-Tuguegarao</u> and <u>Barangay Health</u> Stations;
- 3. MCNP shall comply with all the laws, rules and regulations, issuances, and policies governing such Related Learning Experience as may be prescribed and required by the COMMISION ON HIGHER EDUCATION and other concerned government agencies. It shall be bound to observe and abide by the rules, policies & procedures of PGH- TUGUEGARAO, CHO-Tuguegarao and Barangay Health Stations;
- 4. The MCNP student affiliates shall observe decorum in <u>PGH-TUGUEGARAO</u>, <u>CHO-Tuguegarao and Barangay Health Stations</u>; and shall obey and follow all instructions of <u>PGH-TUGUEGARAO</u>, <u>CHO-Tuguegarao and Barangay Health Stations</u> in so far as those instructions that relate to MCNP students and their community health nursing practice therein;
- The clinical exposure or training of MCNP students-affiliates at <u>PGH-TUGUEGARAO</u>, <u>CHO-Tuguegarao</u> and <u>Barangay Health Stations</u> shall be for the duration they are required to do so based on the approved Community Health Nursing Affiliation Program for the current school year;
- MCNP shall be liable for damages incurred due to losses or breakage of equipment or machine as a result of the deliberate act or negligence of the student intern;
- 7. That the SECOND PARTY shall pay the following fees:

Affiliation Fee :

₱20.00/8 hours/student

User's Fee

P100.00/semester/student

This AGREEMENT may be terminated anytime by both parties.

This Agreement shall be for the period of August 1, 2025 to July 31, 2026 only.
