The members of the committee convened and discussed the request of Hon. Tirso V. Mangada regarding the Food Park in Rotonda

The Committees respectfully submits the herein Committee Report and has the honor to report to this august Body in session the following actions taken, its findings and recommendations.

ACTIONS TAKEN:

The committees conducted a thorough evaluation of the request of Hon. Tirso V. Mangada regarding Food Park in Rotonda. This evaluation was aimed at ensuring that all aspects were thoroughly considered for the information and concurrence of all parties involved.

Resource persons were present to assist the committee in its deliberations.

SUBJECT:

FOOD PARK IN ROTONDA REQUESTED BY HON. TIRSO V. MANGADA

FINDINGS:

1. Article 682 of the Civil Code of the Philippines provides that every building or piece of land is subject to an easement which prohibits the proprietor or possessor from committing nuisance through noise, while Article 26 states that every person shall respect the dignity, personality, privacy and peace of mind of his/her neighbors and other persons.
2. Section 144 of City Ordinance No. 058-2017 titled "City Ordinance Enacting the Comprehensive Environmental Management Code of Tuguegarao City" provides that, "It is further prohibited for any person to cause, create or allow the continuance of any unreasonable or unnecessarily loud, disturbing, unusual or frightening noise or disturbance injurious to the health, peace or quiet of the residents and property owners in any residential area from 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM."
3. The 8th City Council in its Special Session held on October 30, 2020 approved City Ordinance No. 80-08-2020 titled "An Ordinance Prohibiting the Use of Karaoke, Videokes and other Similar Sound Producing Gadgets that Disturb and Disrupt Modular and On-Line Classes among Homes in the 49 Barangays of Tuguegarao City from Monday To Friday (7:00 AM To 9:00 PM) and Saturday (7:00 AM To 5:00 PM), and Providing Penalties for Violations Thereof"
4. City Resolution No. 144-2003 titled "A Resolution Enacting Ordinance No. 08-2003 Entitled: "An Ordinance Regulating the Establishment and Operation of Videoke Bars and Other Places of Similar Nature within 'the City of Tuguegarao and Providing Penalties for Violation Thereof" was enacted by the Sanggunian Panlungsod during its Regular Session held on August 13, 2003.
5. Hon. Mangada explained that the problem arises from the complaint of a concerned citizen residing near the Food Park about the persistent operation of videokes and other sound producing machines/gadgets even during sleeping hours and its operation which is extended up to 4AM.
6. The Chief of Police informed the Body that the problem already reached their office and with the occurrence of stabbing incidents which resulted to the death of victims and other commotions thereat, a Police Post was stationed in front of the Robinsons Place adjacent the Food Park to look into the peace and order situation in the area.

RECOMMENDATION:

After a thorough discussion of the subject matter with the different resource persons the committees came up with the following suggestions:

1. Strict implementation of existing ordinances/resolutions relative to the operation of videokes and other sound producing machine/gadgets.
2. For the concerned Barangay Officials to assist the Tuguegarao City Component Police Station in monitoring peace and order in the Food Park.
3. Police visibility.


4. For the BPLO in coordination with the PNP-TCCPS to visit the site and inform the owners about the problems arising at the Food Park and the complaints of residents surrounding the establishment.

5. To look into the information that there is a separate permit for the use of videoke machines and its possible inclusion in the Ordinance.


