## COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 88-10-2025

#### SUBJECT:

Indorsement of the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que, on the request of the City Agriculturist, Dr. Evangeline P. Calubaquib, for the utilization of a portion of the City Integrated Demo Farm and Training Center which will be used for the installation and operation of two (2) units of recirculating dryers with shed and parking area for one (1) hauling truck to be requested to the Provincial Government of Cagayan.

#### FINDINGS:

1. Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que indorsed to the Tenth City Council the request of the City Agriculturist, Dr. Evangeline P. Calubaquib, for the utilization of a portion of the City Integrated Demo Farm and Training Center which will be used for the installation and operation of two (2) units of recirculating dryers with shed and parking area for one (1) hauling truck to be requested to the Provincial Government of Cagayan.

- 2. The proposed site is strategically located and easily accessible to farmers from various barangays, making it an ideal area for the installation and operation of the facility. The establishment of these facilities will significantly benefit local farmers by reducing post-harvest losses and helping maintain the quality of their produce.
- 3. The two recirculating dryers with shed and the parking area for the hauling truck will be located beside the Tuguegarao City Tobacco Producers Cooperative Building within the vicinity of the City Integrated Demo Farm and Training Center. The total area for the dryers and parking space is 600 square meters, while the dryers with shed measure 18 x 23 meters or 414 square meters. An existing machinery shed for the hauling truck is already located beside the Training Center.
- 4. The Local Government Unit (LGU) will not incur expenses for the dryers with shed, which will be provided by the Department of Agriculture (DA). The LGU will be responsible for site development and the application for a metering device with CAGELCO. The DA will cover electrical line installation up to 20 meters; any additional length beyond 20 meters will be shouldered by the LGU. Engineer Arao confirmed that the proponent can meet the required counterpart.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

After a thorough discussion and deliberation, the Committee recommends the approval of the request of the City Agriculturist, Dr. Evangeline P. Calubaquib, for the utilization of a portion of the City Integrated Demo Farm and Training Center which will be used for the installation and operation of two (2) units of recirculating dryers with shed and parking area for one (1) hauling truck, which will also be provided to be requested to the Provincial Government of Cagayan.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REQUEST OF THE CITY AGRICULTURIST, DR. EVANGELINE P. CALUBAQUIB, FOR THE UTILIZATION OF A PORTION OF THE CITY INTEGRATED DEMO FARM AND TRAINING CENTER FOR THE INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF TWO (2) UNITS OF RECIRCULATING DRYERS WITH SHED AND A PARKING AREA FOR ONE (1) HAULING TRUCK

WHEREAS, the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario S. Ting-Que, indorsed to the Tenth City Council the request of the City Agriculturist, Dr. Evangeline P. Calubaquib, seeking approval for the utilization of a portion of the City Integrated Demo Farm and Training Center for the installation and operation of two (2) units of recirculating dryers with shed and a parking area for one (1) hauling truck;

WHEREAS, the proposed site is strategically located beside the Tuguegarao City Tobacco Producers Cooperative Building within the City Integrated Demo Farm and Training Center, providing farmers from various barangays convenient access to the facility;

WHEREAS, the installation and operation of two (2) units of recirculating dryers with shed and a parking area for one (1) hauling truck will significantly benefit local farmers by reducing post-harvest losses and improving the quality of their produce;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Agriculture (DA) will provide the dryers with shed, while the Local Government Unit (LGU) will be responsible for site development and metering device application with CAGELCO, with additional electrical installation requirements beyond 20 meters to be shouldered by the LGU;

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Agriculture and Food, Market and Livestock Auction Center, after thorough discussion and deliberation, found the request to be advantageous and beneficial to the agricultural sector of Tuguegarao City;

**NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to approve the request of the City Agriculturist Dr. Evangeline P. Calubaquib, for the utilization of a portion of the City Integrated Demo Farm and Training Center for the installation and operation of two (2) units of recirculating dryers with shed and a parking area for one (1) hauling truck;
