After being recognized by the Presiding Officer, Engr. Arao addressed the concerns of Hon. Soriano and explained the following: the identified items in the punch list were the painting of ambulant vendors stalls, and the procurement of 30 units of wooden cabinets for the dry section and 182 sets of swivel bar stool for the food stall, the Tuguegarao City Public Market (Don Domingo) can operate without said punch list and they are waiting for updates from the contractor.

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 12-09-2025

**CITY ORDINANCE DECLARING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF IDENTIFIED
STREETS FOR THE CONDUCT OF KARELA FUN RUN ACTIVITY ON
MARCH 22, 2025 FROM 4:00 AM TO 12:00 NN**

WHEREAS, March is recognized as the National Women’s Month, celebrating the achievements and contributions of women to society and advocating for gender equality;

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Vice Mayor, in support of this advocacy, together with various stakeholders, is organizing “KARELA”, a fun run activity on March 22, 2025, to promote health, fitness and empowerment among women and the entire community;

WHEREAS, to ensure that safety and smooth conduct of the fun run, a temporary road closure is necessary along designated routes during the event;

WHEREAS, Section 21 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers a local government unit to temporarily close or open any local road falling within its jurisdiction, through an ordinance;

WHEREAS, the City Government recognizes that it can resume enforcement of regular traffic flow in the City as soon as the activity is completed, to prevent further disruption of the usual traffic flow of the riding public.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **ORDAINED** by the Ninth City Council in session assembled to enact to following Ordinance:

Section 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as “*City Ordinance Declaring the Temporary Closure of Identified Streets for the Conduct of KARELA Fun Run Activity on March 22, 2025 from 4:00 AM to 12:00 NN.*”

Section 2. Scope and Limitation. This Ordinance shall cover the temporary closure of the following streets on March 22, 2025 from 4:00 AM to 12:00 NN:

1. Bagay Road from corner CSU Andrews to corner Tramo Road
2. Tramo Road
3. Caritan Highway from corner Tramo Road to corner CSU Andrews
4. Diversion Road from corner Bagay Road to corner Caritan Highway

Section 3. Information. This Ordinance shall be disseminated through signages and all mass media outlets in the city including the Tuguegarao City Information Office.

Section 4. Implementation. The Tuguegarao City Traffic Management Group (TCTMG) in coordination with the Tuguegarao Component City Police Station shall ensure the smooth traffic flow of the affected streets under this Ordinance. They will also assist in the traffic control of affected roads, as well as security and safety of all participants.

Section 5. Repealing Clause. Ordinances, executive orders and other local legislations inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby modified or repealed accordingly.

Section 6. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect on March 22, 2025 from 4:00 AM to 12:00 NN.

19 The Members of the Joint Committees met and deliberated on the Draft Ordinance
20 Institutionalizing the Katipunan ng Kabataan Identification System and the Creation of
21 Youth Information Database in Tuguegarao City. The Joint Committees respectfully submit
22 the herein Committee Report and have the honor to report to this August Body, in session
23 assembled, the following actions taken, their findings and recommendations.

25 **ACTIONS TAKEN:**

27 1. The joint committees conducted a thorough and wholistic evaluation on the Draft
28 Ordinance Institutionalizing the Katipunan ng Kabataan Identification System and the
29 Creation of Youth Information Database in Tuguegarao City on February 10, 2025.
30 2. Resource persons were present to assist the joint committees in the committee
31 deliberation.
32

33 **FINDINGS:**

- 34
35 1. Republic Act 10742, also known as *Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015*,
36 recognizes the existence of the Katipunan ng Kabataan, composed of all citizens of the
37 Philippines domiciled in the barangay for at least six (6) months, who are at least fifteen
38 (15) but not more than thirty (30) years of age and who are duly registered in the list
39 of the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) and/or the records of the Sangguniang
40 Kabataan secretary.
41 2. Department of Interior and Local Government Memorandum Circular 2023-03-23-211
42 strengthens and reiterates the role of the Sangguniang Kabataan to conduct youth
43 profiling, establish, maintain and update a database of youth in the barangay and ensure
44 submission to the Commission, and proper turn-over to the next set of SK officials as
45 stipulated in the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 10742.
46 3. The institutionalization of the Katipunan ng Kabataan Identification System will
47 improve the delivery of basic services for the Youth, both in the Barangay and the City,
48 making it faster, more efficient, and more convenient on the part of the residents, and
49 will contribute to their active participation in policy making for their development.
50 4. The Katipunan ng Kabataan Identification System will enable the Sangguniang
51 Kabataan to establish a Youth Information Database, the entries of which can be used
52 by the Sangguniang Kabataan Council in crafting policies, programs and projects to
53 advance the welfare of the Katipunan ng Kabataan.
54 5. The said identification system will hasten and simplify the processing and release of
55 other Barangay documents such as Barangay Clearance, Certifications and the like as
56 the information of the Katipunan ng Kabataan member are already available in the
57 information system.
58 6. The identification system shall also aid in the verification of registered Katipunan ng
59 Kabataan members in the barangay to update the Katipunan ng Kabataan profiling and
60 shall be used in the provision of services in relation to Youth Development within the
61 City of Tuguegarao.

7. All other suggestions and recommendations made by the parties during the joint committee hearing are already incorporated in the Draft Ordinance.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

After a thorough discussion and finding the ordinance to be with merit and beneficial to the constituents of Tuguegarao City, the joint committees favorably recommend the approval of the Draft Ordinance Institutionalizing the Katipunan ng Kabataan Identification System and the Creation of Youth Information Database in Tuguegarao City.
