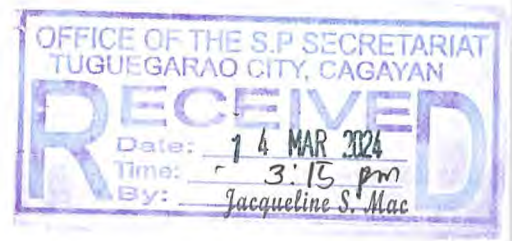

MOTION

(TO ENTER INTO PLEA BARGAIN)

The accused Orlando Pascual y Aglugub assisted by the Public Attorney's Office through the undersigned unto the Honorable Court, respectfully submit this Motion for Its consideration.

1. The accused unilaterally intimated to the undersigned that he sincerely desires to enter into a plea bargain.
2. The undersigned explained to him in layman's term about the status of his case, the pieces of evidence and witnesses of the prosecution vis-à-vis his own in the event the case proceeds to full-blown trial – without however insinuating possible outcome of the eventual Judgment. In view of such development, the undersigned told him that he can plea bargain under Article 315 (4) of the Revised Penal Code.
3. The undersigned then meticulously explained to him the consequences in the event the prosecution agrees and the Honorable Court grants the plea bargain, *viz., he will be admitting a crime as under Article 315 (4) of the Revised Penal Code punishable by arresto mayor in its medium and maximum*

periods considering that the amount of fraud involved in the case does not exceed P40,000 – with the hope of being granted later of probation.

4. Without really assuming at all, in case the penalties imposed in the Judgment is probationable, he will be applying for it and in view thereof, the undersigned clearly asked the accused in the vernacular language known to him whether he was *previously convicted of a crime by final judgment concerning national security, or with imprisonment of more than six (6) months and one (1) day and/or a fine of more than one thousand pesos (P1,000.00), or been once on probation – on all he answered in the negative.* The undersigned also asked the accused *whether he is a recidivist, habitual offender, drug addict or troublemaker, likewise on all he again answered in the negative.*

The accused appeals before the Honorable Court that this Motion may find merit and consideration.

Other relief just and equitable under the premises are likewise prayed for.

AMENDED 2nd MOTION TO ENTER INTO PLEA BARGAINING AGREEMENT

ACCUSED REY GALLIBU, through the Public Attorney's Office, by undersigned counsel, unto the Honorable Court, most respectfully states that:

1. Private complainant local government unit of Tuguegarao City agreed to the proposal of accused to a plea bargain from Estafa through falsification of public document to simple estafa.

2. However, private complainant LGU did not agree to the proposal for the dismissal of the separate charge of violation of RA 3019.

3. In light of the foregoing, accused proposes that he shall also voluntarily plead to the offense of simple estafa for the present charge of violation of RA 3019, which plea bargain is supported by prevailing jurisprudence.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, it is most respectfully prayed of the Honorable Court to give due course to accused's Motion to Enter into a Plea Bargaining Agreement, allowing the accused to voluntarily plead to two (2) counts of simple estafa as a plea bargain to the two instant charges of estafa with falsification and violation of RA 3019.

Other relief just and equitable are likewise prayed for. Tuguegarao City, November 14, 2022.
