WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay recognizes the critical role of food security and nutrition in enhancing the quality of life for its residents;

WHEREAS, community gardens can significantly contribute to food security and nutrition by providing fresh, healthy and affordable fruits and vegetables to residents;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), particularly Section 16, empowers local government units to exercise the power to promote the general welfare of their constituents;

WHEREAS, Section 389 (b) of the Local Government Code allows the Sangguniang Barangay to establish and maintain facilities and programs that will improve the quality of life of the residents;

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture (DA) and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) have jointly committed to intensify the implementation of the "Halina't Magtanim ng Prutas at Gulay, Kadiwa'y Yaman, Plants for Bountiful Barangays Movement" (HAPAG kay PBBM) Program, a whole-of-government initiative aimed at enhancing food security, alleviating poverty, and fostering community engagement through urban and peri-urban agriculture;

WHEREAS, the establishment of the Halina't Magtanim ng Prutas at Gulay (HAPAG) sa Barangay Community Garden Project will promote resident involvement and encourage residents to actively participate in agricultural practices;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Sangguniang Barangay of San Gabriel does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Title

This ordinance shall be known as the "Halina't Magtanim ng Prutas at Gulay (HAPAG) sa Barangay Community Garden Project Ordinance."

Section 2. Declaration of Policy

The Sangguniang Barangay recognizes the importance of food security and nutrition in the community. It also acknowledges the potential of community gardens to contribute positively to food security by providing fresh, healthy and affordable fruits and vegetables to the community.

Section 3. Establishment of Barangay Community Garden

There is hereby established a Barangay Community Garden, referred to as the HAPAG sa Barangay Community Garden Project, in Barangay San Gabriel. The HAPAG Garden shall be located in the following area (s):

- Lot beside of the Barangay Multi-Purpose Building of San Gabriel (Model Community Garden;
- Per Household Backyard Garden.

Section 4. Management and Operation of the HAPAG Garden

- The HAPAG Garden shall be managed and operated by the BLGU-San Gabriel through the Sangguniang Barangay and in coordination with the existing organizations in the barangay: Rural Improvement Club (RIC) and the Purok-Based Organization.
- The Punong Barangay shall appoint a member of the Sangguniang Barangay as the focal person to oversee the day-to-day operations of the Garden.
- The focal person shall have the following duties:
 - a. Oversee the daily operations of the Garden;
 - b. Ensure proper maintenance of the HAPAG Garden;
 - c. Coordinate with the Barangay Council on the development and implementation of programs and activities for the HAPAG Community Garden;
 - d. Promote the use of the HAPAG Community Garden by residents;
 - e. Encourage residents to establish their own household gardens;

- f. Seek funding and resources for the HAPAG Community Garden;
- g. Conduct Trainings regarding Backyard Gardening; and
- h. Perform such other duties as may be assigned by the Barangay Council.

Section 5. Use of Barangay Community Garden

The HAPAG Community Garden shall be used for the following purposes:

- 1. Growing fruits, herbs and vegetables;
- 2. Conduct educational programs on agriculture and nutrition;
- 3. Provide a space for residents to gather and socialize; and
- 4. Other purposes as may be determined by the Sangguniang Barangay.

Section 6. Funding The HAPAG

Community Garden shall be funded from the following sources:

- a. Barangay funds;
- b. Donations from individuals and organizations; and
- c. Other sources as may be identified by the Sangguniang Barangay.

Section 7. Sale of Products and Fund Management

- a. The fruits, vegetables and other products harvested from the HAPAG Community Garden may be sold to residents or other interested buyers to generate funds for the maintenance and development of the project.
- b. The proceeds from the sale of these products shall be collected and remitted to the Barangay Treasurer's Office.
- c. The proceeds shall be treated as a revolving fund or trust fund dedicated solely to the operations, maintenance and sustainability of the HAPAG Community Garden Project.

Section 8. Rules and Regulations

The Sangguniang Barangay may promulgate rules and regulations governing the use of the HAPAG Community Garden. These rules and regulations may include, but are not limited to, the following:

Types of Plants That May Be Grown

- o Residents are encouraged to cultivate fruits, vegetables, herbs and medicinal plants that are suitable for the local climate and soil conditions.
- o Prohibited plants include:
 - Invasive species that may harm other plants or the environment.
 - Plants requiring excessive water or harmful chemicals to maintain.
 - Plants designated for commercial, ornamental or non-edible purposes unless specifically approved.

Hours of Operation of the Garden

- o The HAPAG Community Garden shall be open daily from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM for safety and proper monitoring.
- Access outside these hours is strictly prohibited unless special permission is granted by the Barangay Council through the Punong Barangay.

Procedures for Obtaining Permission to Use the Community Garden

- Residents or groups wishing to utilize the garden must submit a written request to the Barangay Council through the Punong Barangay, specifying:
 - The purpose of use (e.g., planting, harvesting, educational activity).
 - The proposed duration and scope of use.
- o Permission will be granted on a first-come, first-served basis, subject to the availability of space and resources.

- o Approved users will be issued a permit valid for the specified duration.
- Penalties for Violating Rules and Regulations
 Violators of the rules governing the HAPAG Community Garden shall be subject to the following penalties:
 - o First Offense Warning
 - o Second Offense Fine of P500.00
 - o Third and Subsequent Offenses Fine of P1,000.00.

Section 9. Severability Clause

If any provision of this ordinance is held to be invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 10. Effectivity

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160) recognizes the importance of empowering local communities through the establishment of grassroots governance structures, including the Purok system, to effectively deliver basic services;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay acknowledges the vital role of Purok offices and their members in facilitating community engagement and promoting active participation in local governance;

WHEREAS, the implementation of the Galing Purok Award System aims to incentivize and recognize Purok offices and their members for their contributions to the barangay in areas such as solid waste management, environmental management, peace and order, Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (BDRRRM), gender and development and other essential services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay San Gabriel, as follows:

Section 1. Title

This ordinance shall be known as the "An Ordinance Establishing Governance and Galing Award System at the Purok Level in Barangay San Gabriel"

Section 2. Establishment of the Purok System

The Purok System of Governance is hereby reaffirmed and supported in Barangay San Gabriel, in alignment with the provisions of Sangguniang Barangay

Ordinance No. 21-2018, titled: "An Ordinance Acknowledging the Various Established Puroks in the Barangay of San Gabriel as Institutionalized People's Organizations, Defining the Extent and Limits of its Power and Functions as Such, Fixing a Uniform Term of Office for Purok Officials Including Their Duties and Responsibilities and for Other Purpose."

Under Ordinance No. 21-2018, the Purok System was institutionalized as a governance structure to strengthen local participation, improve service delivery and organize community initiatives. This provision reaffirms and operationalizes the governance framework established by the ordinance, stressing the Puroks' role in coordinating activities and advancing barangay development goals. The designated leaders and members of each Purok shall continue to carry out the duties and responsibilities defined therein, ensuring alignment with barangay priorities and community welfare.

Section 3. Policy Statement

Consistent under section 34, 35 and 36, Title 1 Book 1 of RA 7160, otherwise known as Local Government Code of 1991, the Sanggunian in pursuit of acknowledging the Established Puroks in the Barangay of San Gabriel as its institutionalized Peoples' Organizations (POS) hereby adhere to the following policies, to wit:

a. That the Barangay Government of San Gabriel shall commit to respect the existence and operation of the purok as an independent non-partisan community of people whose organization as such is outside of government intervention maybe







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Sponsored and Authored by: **HON. DOMINADOR O. TAMAYAO** deemed appropriate or necessary in the interest of promoting public service or the general welfare.

- b. That the Barangay Government of San Gabriel to enable the purok become empowered partners of the government and non-government organizations (NGOS) towards full development through such means that support the POS to develop into self-sufficient organization of people.
- c. That the Barangay Government of San Gabriel shall commit to pursue the reorganization and institutionalization of the Puroks as POS within the ambit of the pertinent provisions of RA 7160, its implementing Rules and Regulations the applicable rules and regulation of the DILG and such other related laws, rules and regulations.
- d. That the institutionalization of the purok shall cause to deliberate its role as POs established merely to promote socio-economic activities as distinguished from the Barangays which is being recognized as the smallest political entity used for governance either as a primary planning and implementing unit, or a forum wherein the collective views of the maybe expressed, crystalized and considered and where disputes maybe amicably settled.
- e. That the institutionalization of the purok shall, by no means, be used as instrument of any sort of partisan, politics or facilities to directly or indirectly cater, at any given period of time, to the processes or interest of any sort by Partisan politics through the individual or concerted actions of purok officers.







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- f. That the institutionalization of the purok shall be for the chief purpose of enabling the organization to independently carry out its power and functions as such and to efficiently and effectively assist the Barangay Government and other agencies towards achieving their respective goals.
- g. That the institutionalization of the Purok shall under no circumstances or period of time, cause to confer upon this POs Police power or any semblance thereof.
- h. That the Galing Award System at the Purok Level in Barangay San Gabriel shall encourage community engagement and active participation in local governance by recognizing and rewarding the efforts of Purok leaders and members in assisting the barangay government in providing essential services and serving the public interest.

Section 4. Objectives of the Galing Purok Award System

- 1. Recognize and reward Purok leaders and their members for outstanding contributions to the barangay.
- 2. Encourage Purok leaders and their members to actively participate in the delivery of basic services.
- Promote healthy competition among Puroks to improve community services and programs by nurturing innovation and creativity in service delivery and program implementation.
- 4. Strengthen collaboration between Puroks and the Sangguniang Barangay in addressing community needs.







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Section 5. Categories for Evaluation

1. Administration

This category assesses the efficiency and effectiveness of Purok offices in governance and organizational management. Evaluation criteria include compliance with administrative processes, proper documentation and reporting, transparent decision-making and adherence to barangay policies. Purok leaders are also measured on their ability to mobilize members, maintain active communication channels and ensure that all activities are aligned with the barangay's overarching goals.

2. Social Services

The performance of Puroks in delivering social services is evaluated in this category, focusing on their contributions to health, education, safety and community welfare programs. Examples include participation in vaccination campaigns, organizing/ coordinating health and nutrition seminars, disaster preparedness efforts and promoting educational initiatives. The goal is to determine how Puroks support the barangay in improving residents' quality of life through targeted and inclusive social services.

3. Environmental Management

This category evaluates the Puroks' efforts in promoting and implementing solid waste management, environmental protection and sustainability programs. Key activities include tree planting, vegetable production, cleanliness drives, proper waste segregation and addressing local







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Sponsored and Authored by: **HON. DOMINADOR O. TAMAYAO** environmental issues such as flooding or pollution. The assessment highlights how Puroks contribute to maintaining a clean, green and environmentally sustainable barangay.

4. Economic Development

Purok offices are assessed on their initiatives to support and stimulate local economic growth. This may include organizing livelihood programs, attending/organizing skill development workshops or small-scale enterprises that empower residents and provide economic opportunities. Puroks are also evaluated on their participation in barangay fairs, local markets and/or projects that generate employment or boost community income.

5. Other Categories as May Be Determined by the Sangguniang Barangay
Each category aligns with the BGPMS framework, which highlights
participatory governance, transparency, accountability and the efficient
delivery of services to promote the holistic development of the barangay and
its constituents.

Section 6. Evaluation Process

1. The evaluation of Purok offices shall be conducted per semester by a committee formed by the Sangguniang Barangay.

The evaluation committee will comprise representative/s from the Sangguniang Barangay, including the Punong Barangay, Barangay Secretary, Barangay Treasurer and potentially non-partisan stakeholders or local experts, as recommended by the Department of the Interior and Local Government







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(DILG). Conducting evaluations on a semester basis ensures regular monitoring, allowing for timely recognition of accomplishments and identification of areas needing improvement.

The committee shall be responsible for the development, administration, monitoring and evaluation of the Galing Purok Award System of the Barangay. The committee shall meet semi-annually or quarterly if necessary to perform the following tasks:

- i. Formulate, adopt and amend internal rules, policies and procedures to govern the conduct of its activities which shall include the guidelines in evaluating the nominees and the mechanics for recognizing the awardees;
- ii. Determine the forms of awards and incentives to be granted;
- iii. Monitor implementation of approved suggestions and ideas through feedback and reports;
- iv. Prepare plans, identify resources and proposed budgets for the system on an annual basis;
- v. Document past practices, innovative ideas and success stories which shall serve as promotional materials to sustain interest and enthusiasm;
- vi. Address issues relative to the awards and incentives within fifteen (15) days from date of submission;
- vii. Monitor and evaluate the system's implementation every year and make essential improvements to ensure its sustainability.







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- 2. Criteria for evaluation shall include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Active participation in community initiatives

This criterion assesses the level of engagement of Purok offices in activities that contribute to barangay development, such as clean-up drives, health campaigns, disaster preparedness exercises and educational programs. Using the BGPMS framework, participation is measured not only by attendance but also by the quality of involvement and leadership demonstrated during these initiatives.

b. Effective implementation of programs related to the evaluation categories

Purok offices will be evaluated based on their success in executing programs under the identified categories: Administration, Social Services, Environmental Management, Economic Development and other relevant areas. The evaluation will emphasize measurable outcomes, such as the number of beneficiaries reached, the achievement of project objectives and adherence to timelines and budgets. Evidence of proper planning, execution and documentation will also be considered.

c. Collaboration with Barangay Officials and other Stakeholders

This criterion examines the Puroks' ability to work closely with the Sangguniang Barangay, government agencies, NGOs and private sector partners. Drawing from the BGPMS principles, effective collaboration is demonstrated through coordinated efforts, resource-







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Sponsored and Authored by: **HON. DOMINADOR O. TAMAYAO**sharing and consistent communication with stakeholders to achieve common goals. It highlights how well the Puroks integrate into the broader governance framework.

d. Community feedback and involvement

Community feedback serves as a direct indicator of the Purok offices' performance. Regular surveys, consultations and forums are employed to gather residents' opinions on the Purok's services and initiatives. This aspect aligns with the DILG's participatory governance approach, where public satisfaction, inclusivity and engagement are critical factors. A high level of community involvement in Purok-led activities reflects trust, relevance and responsiveness to local needs.

By grounding the evaluation process in the BGPMS and DILG methodologies, the barangay establishes a systematic, transparent approach aligned with national standards for local governance, while promoting continuous development at the Purok level.

Section 7. Definition of Terms

For the purpose of this ordinance, the following words and phrases shall apply:

1. Purok System - A grassroots governance structure within Barangay San Gabriel aimed at strengthening local participation, improving service delivery and organizing community initiatives.







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- Galing Purok Award System A program established to recognize and reward
 the efforts of Purok offices and their members for their contributions to the
 barangay in various areas, such as community engagement, service delivery
 and development programs.
- Sangguniang Barangay The legislative body of Barangay San Gabriel responsible for passing ordinances, approving resolutions and overseeing local governance activities.
- Barangay Assembly Day A bi-annual event where the performance of Purok offices and members is recognized, and awards are presented for exemplary contributions to the community.
- 5. Participatory Governance A system of governance in which the community members actively participate in decision-making processes, ensuring that their voices are heard and considered in the development of policies and programs.
- 6. NGOs Non-Governmental Organizations, which are independent groups working in various sectors, including community development, health, education and environmental sustainability, often in partnership with local government units (LGUs).
- 7. Incentives Rewards or benefits provided to Purok offices and their members for their outstanding performance and contributions to the community.
- 8. Community Feedback The input or opinions gathered from barangay residents regarding the effectiveness and impact of Purok-led initiatives and services, used as a measure of satisfaction and engagement.

Section 8. Awards and Recognition

- The top-performing Purok shall be awarded the "Galing Purok Award" during the Barangay Assembly Day held twice a year (per semester) or at any designated recognition event.
- 2. Certificates of recognition and other incentives may be provided to the winning Purok office and its members, with additional awards given per category to acknowledge specific achievements in areas such as Administration, Social Services, Environmental Management, Economic Development and other relevant categories.

Section 9. Funding

The implementation of this ordinance, including the Galing Purok Award System, shall be funded by the Barangay's annual budget, donations and other resources as may be available. This provision allocates the necessary financial support for the Galing Purok Award System from the Barangay's existing budget, which is regularly approved by the Sangguniang Barangay. Additionally, the barangay may seek financial support through donations from individuals, businesses or non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that share an interest in promoting community development and local governance. Other resources may include grants,

Section 10. Rules and Regulations

The Sangguniang Barangay shall promulgate rules and regulations to support the effective implementation of the Purok System and the Galing Purok Award System.

Section 11. Severability Clause

Section 12. Effectivity

WHEREAS, the increasing demand for services and responsibilities assigned to the barangay, particularly those related to the Barangay Secretary and Treasurer, underscores the necessity of having a barangay clerk to assist and manage these tasks effectively, thus making it important to clearly outline the duties and responsibilities of the Barangay Clerk to promote efficient administrative operations, particularly in financial management, documentation and community engagement.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Barangay of San Gabriel Section 1. Title

This Ordinance shall be known as the "Barangay Clerk Appointment, Duties and Responsibilities Ordinance."

Section 2. Appointment of the Barangay Clerk

- The Punong Barangay shall appoint the Barangay Clerk, who shall serve under the supervision of the Barangay Treasurer, Barangay Secretary and the Punong Barangay.
- The appointment shall be based on qualifications, experience and ability to perform the required duties.

- Barangay Clerk Refers to the appointed official responsible for assisting in the administrative functions of the barangay, including financial management, documentation and community engagement.
- Punong Barangay The elected head of the barangay, responsible for overseeing the governance and administration of the barangay, including the appointment of officials and staff.
- Administrative Operations Refers to the processes and activities related to the management and organization of the barangay's resources and services.
- Financial Management The planning, organizing, directing and controlling of financial activities within the barangay, including budgeting, accounting and revenue collection.
- Community Engagement The involvement and interaction of the barangay with its constituents, aimed at fostering communication, participation and collaboration in local governance.

Section 4. Primary Duties and Responsibilities

The Barangay Clerk shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- 1. Assist the Barangay Treasurer in maintaining accurate financial records, including the preparation of financial reports, collection of revenues and disbursement of funds.
- 2. Responsible for processing and issuing various barangay certificates and clearances, including but not limited to certificates of residency, good moral character and other necessary documentation for residents.
- 3. Maintain a systematic record of all certificates and clearances issued to ensure accountability and traceability.
- 4. Assist in canvassing duties for supplies, services and other barangay needs, to ensure transparency and efficiency in procurement processes.
- 5. Serve as the primary point of contact for residents seeking information about barangay programs, services and activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Barangay of San Gabriel, in session duly assembled:

Section 1. Title

This Ordinance shall be known as the "Barangay Utility Workers Appointment, Duties and Responsibilities Ordinance."

Section 2. Legal Basis for Establishing the Position

The Local Government Code allows the Sangguniang Barangay to create additional positions within the barangay, as may be necessary, provided that such positions are covered by an ordinance.

Section 3. Appointment of Barangay Utility Workers

• Two Barangay Utility Workers shall be appointed: one male and one female, to promote gender representation. The male utility worker will handle heavier tasks that require physical strength, while the female utility worker will focus on detailed and organized work, contributing to a well-rounded approach to maintaining cleanliness and order within the barangay.

- 2. Assist in the implementation of barangay programs and activities, particularly those related to community service, disaster preparedness and environmental protection.
- 3. Provide support during barangay events and gatherings, including setup, logistics and cleanup.
- 4. Work in coordination with other barangay officials and staff to address community needs and enhance service delivery.
- 5. Perform other duties and responsibilities as directed by the Punong Barangay or other barangay officials.

Section 5. Definition of Terms

- Barangay Utility Worker Refers to the appointed personnel responsible for assisting in the maintenance and operational activities of the barangay.
- Punong Barangay The elected head of the barangay, responsible for overseeing governance and administration.
- Public Spaces Areas within the barangay that are accessible to the community.
- Community Programs Initiatives and activities organized by the barangay aimed at improving the welfare and engagement of residents.

Section 6. Reporting and Accountability

The Barangay Utility Workers shall report regularly to the Punong Barangay regarding their activities, community needs and any issues encountered during their duties.

WHEREAS, Section 399 of the same Act establishes the Katarungang Pambarangay (KP) system, empowering barangays to provide accessible, efficient and community-based conflict resolution services to address minor disputes among residents and reduce court congestion;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160 (Local Government Code of 1991) mandates that barangays shall provide basic services and facilities, including offices that support local administration and public welfare, thereby empowering the Sangguniang Barangay to establish, maintain or relocate such offices to ensure effective service delivery;

WHEREAS, the current location of the Katarungang Pambarangay Office on the 3rd floor of the barangay multi-purpose building poses accessibility challenges, particularly for elderly individuals, persons with disabilities and residents with limited mobility who seek assistance from the KP Office;

WHEREAS, in light of the barangay's commitment to providing accessible and effective public services, it is deemed appropriate to relocate the KP Office to the 1st floor of the barangay multi-purpose building, ensuring better access for all residents, thus furthering the goals of the Katarungang Pambarangay system;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, also known as the Local Government Code of 1991, grants local government units (LGUs) the power to enact measures to protect the welfare of their constituents, especially in times of emergencies and disasters;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of the Local Government Code of 1991 further mandates barangays to provide basic services and facilities, including those that enhance public safety and prepare the community for disaster response;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10121, also known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, emphasizes the importance of preparedness, mitigation and response in minimizing risks and ensuring community resilience, thereby mandating local government units to establish evacuation centers and emergency response facilities;

WHEREAS, Barangay San Gabriel recognizes the need for a designated evacuation facility that is easily accessible to all residents, especially the vulnerable sectors, to ensure their safety and well-being in times of natural and man-made disasters;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Barangay of San Gabriel, in session duly assembled:

Section 1. Title

This Ordinance shall be known as the "Barangay San Gabriel Evacuation Facility Ordinance."

Section 2. Purpose

The purpose of this Ordinance is to designate, establish and maintain an evacuation facility in Barangay San Gabriel that will serve as a safe shelter for residents during emergencies and disasters.

Section 3. Definition of Terms

- Evacuation Facility A designated structure or area established for temporary shelter and safety of residents during emergencies, disasters or calamities.
- Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Activities, programs and policies that aim to prevent or mitigate the impact of natural and manmade hazards.

Section 4. Designation of the Evacuation Facility

- The Barangay Evacuation Facility shall be designated as the official evacuation site, located on the second floor of the Barangay Multi-Purpose Hall or an alternative safe and accessible area within the barangay, as determined by the Barangay Council.
- The facility shall be equipped and maintained with necessary supplies and provisions, such as first aid kits, food, water, sanitation and hygiene items, for use during emergencies for the safety, security and well-being of evacuees during emergencies and disasters.

Section 5. Maintenance and Management

- The Barangay Council shall allocate funds for the maintenance of the evacuation facility and ensure that it is structurally sound, secure and accessible to all barangay residents.
- Regular inspections and disaster preparedness drills shall be conducted to ensure the facility is prepared for immediate use in times of emergency.

Section 6. Public Information and Awareness

- The Barangay Council shall conduct regular information drives to educate residents on the location, use and importance of the evacuation facility.
- Maps and clear signage directing residents to the facility shall be posted in prominent areas within the barangay.

Section 7. Implementation and Compliance

- The Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Committee (BDRRMC) shall oversee the implementation of this Ordinance and ensure the facility's readiness and accessibility.
- Barangay officials and personnel are directed to provide assistance during evacuations and maintain order within the evacuation facility.

Section 8. Funding

Funds required for establishing, equipping and maintaining the evacuation facility shall be sourced from the barangay's general fund, the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF) or other available sources.

Section 9. Separability Clause

If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 10. Repealing Clause

All barangay resolutions, ordinances or issuances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 11. Effectivity Clause

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and posting in the barangay hall and other conspicuous places for public awareness.

These were respectfully addressed by the proponent, Hon. SB Member Dominador O. Tamayao, together with Hon. Punong Barangay Joseph Petricio P. Salagan.

The active participation of residents greatly contributed to the improvement of the proposed ordinances, as their valuable input and constructive feedback were considered in refining the provisions.

Dear Hon. Tamayao:

This legal review addresses your proposed barangay ordinances. This review examines the legal framework, potential conflicts with existing laws, clarity, enforceability, and constitutional considerations.

After perusal on the proposed barangay ordinances of Barangay San Gabriel, this Office concludes that the said proposed barangay ordinances have complied with all the legal requirements and the same were not in conflict with the Local Government Code of 1991, and any existing laws, rules and regulations except the "Ordinance Prohibiting any Illegal Structures and Obstructions on Public Roads and Other Similar Public Places within the Territorial Jurisdiction of Barangay San Gabriel of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan.

The enactment of this ordinance is an ultra vires act. The Local Government Code of 1991 does not grant the Sanggunian Barangay the power to regulate the public roads/streets. Under the code, particularly Section 458 Paragraph (5) (vi), it is the Sanggunian Panglungsod who has the power to regulate public roads/streets which states that:

"Regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon, and when necessary in the interest of public welfare, authorize the removal or encroachments and illegal constructions in public places"

Furthermore, the DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2023-017 does not grant the Barangay the power to enact an ordinance in order to perform its directed duties. As can be gleaned from the said Circular, particularly under Section 3.2.4.1 thereof which provides that the enforcement of no-parking, one-side parking, or other similar strategies, must be in accordance with the ordinance duly enacted by Sangguniang Bayan/Panglungsod and not by the Sanggunian Barangay.

This legal opinion is provided for your guidance, and we remain available for any further clarification or assistance you may require.
