AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE NO. 04-09-2025 TITLED "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 AND SECTION 3 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 17-2002 TITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING CERTAIN ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE PREMISES OF THE TUGUEGARAO CITY AIRPORT"

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that "Every Local Government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied there from, as well as powers necessary, appropriate incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those who are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;"

WHEREAS, Memorandum Circular No. 023-2024 of the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) titled "Amendment to Philippine Civil Aviation Regulations Air Navigation Services (CAR-ANS) Part 15 Adopting Amendment 43 to ICAO Annex 15- Aeronautical Information Services," particularly, 15.5.3.3.4 states that "For aerodromes regularly used by international civil aviation, additional terrain data should be provided within Area 2 (b) within the area between 10 km and the Terminal Maneuvering Area (TMA) boundary or a 45km radius (whichever is smaller);"

WHEREAS, Hon. Bienvenido C. De Guzman II sponsored a Draft Ordinance Amending City Ordinance No. 17-2002 Regulating Certain Activities within the Premises of the Tuguegarao City Airport which was included in the agenda of the 109th Regular Session of the Ninth City Council and was referred to the joint Committee on Transportation as the lead committee and Committee on Rules, Laws and Ethics;

WHEREAS, after a deliberation in a committee meeting held for the said purpose, the said Committees found the request to be in order and beneficial to the constituents of Tuguegarao City;

WHEREAS, after the approval of the concomitant committee report, the Ninth City Council during its 121st Regular Session held on January 14, 2025 deemed it proper and necessary to approve the herein ordinance;

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing for this consideration was held on January 22, 2025 at the Sangguniang Panlungsod Session Hall.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, in session assembled, to enact:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 AND SECTION 3 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 17-2002 TITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING CERTAIN ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE PREMISES OF THE TUGUEGARAO CITY AIRPORT."

SECTION 2. AMENDMENTS.

Section 1 and Section 3 of Ordinance No. 17-2002 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. No kite or kites, pigeons, drones and balloons and any other flying gadgets shall be flown or caused to be flown within the radius of ten (10) kilometers from the center of the Tuguegarao City Airport.

Section 2. No person, vehicle or animal shall, without the permission from the Civil Aeronautics Administration Office, enter or loiter or be allowed to enter or loiter within the runway premises of the Tuguegarao City Airport and other designated areas thereof to which entry is prohibited by said Office.

Section 3. Any person who violates the provision of this Ordinance shall be fined:

First Offense – a fine of One thousand pesos (P1,000.00) Second Offense – a fine of Three thousand pesos (P3,000.00) Third Offense – a fine of five thousand pesos (P5,000.00)

SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTATION. For purpose of enforcement, the Air Transportation Office shall be deputized to implement the ordinance.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions not affected thereby shall remain and continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any resolution or ordinance or part thereof not consistent with the provision of this ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall be effective upon the upholding of its validity by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and the eventual fifteen (15) days publication thereafter.

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 06-09-2025

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE NO. 04-09-2025 TITLED "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 AND SECTION 3 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 17-2002 TITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING CERTAIN ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE PREMISES OF THE TUGUEGARAO CITY AIRPORT"

This City Ordinance was forwarded to the Office of the City Mayor on February 25, 2025 and was returned **UNSIGNED** on March 17, 2025. Relative to this, Section 54(b) of the Local Government Code states that:

"SECTION 54. Approval of Ordinances. - (a) Every ordinance enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Sangguniang Panlungsod, or Sangguniang bayan shall be presented to the provincial governor or city or municipal mayor, as the case may be. If the local chief executive concerned approves the same, he shall affix his signature on each and every page thereof; otherwise, he shall veto it and return the same with his objections to the Sanggunian, which may proceed to reconsider the same. The Sanggunian concerned may override the veto of the local chief executive by two-thirds (2/3) vote of all its members, thereby making the ordinance or resolution effective for all legal intents and purposes.

(b) The veto shall be communicated by the local chief executive concerned to the Sanggunian within fifteen (15) days in the case of a province, and <u>ten (10) days in the case of a city or a municipality; otherwise,</u> <u>the ordinance shall be deemed approved as if he had signed it</u>."</u>
