CITY ORDINANCE NO. 25-09-2024

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14(A) OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 32-08-2019 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE TUGUEGARAO CITY REVISED COCKFIGHTING ORDINANCE OF 2005

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that each local government unit shall exercise its power to create its own sources of revenue and has to levy taxes, fees and charges consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor, Hon. Maila Rosario s. Ting-Que, indorsed to the Ninth City Council the letter of the City Treasurer, Mr. Buenaventura F. Lagundi, relative to the amendment of Section 14(A) of City Ordinance No. 32-08-2019;

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend City Ordinance No. 32-08-2019, particularly Section 14(A), to cover up the shortfall of collection from amusement tax; that is to impose a permit fee on the use of computerized betting machine in lieu of amusement tax on admission fees;

NOW, **THEREFORE**, be it **ORDAINED** by the Sangguninag Panlungsod, in session assembled, to enact:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. An amendment shall be incorporated:

The computerized betting machine should be officially registered in the City Treasurer's Office to be able to monitor gross receipts as basis for the computation of business tax.

SECTION 2. TIME AND MANNER OF PAYMENT. The fees should be paid every after the conduct of cockfight to the duly authorized representative of the City Treasurer's Office. Provided further that in case of failure to pay on time as prescribed in this Ordinance, a surcharge of 25% shall be imposed.

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions not affected thereby shall remain and continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any and resolutions or ordinances or parts thereof not consistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

All other laws governing cockfighting shall remain applicable and must be construed in harmony with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14(A) OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 32-08-2019 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE TUGUEGARAO CITY REVISED COCKFIGHTING ORDINANCE OF 2005


This City Ordinance was forwarded to the Office of the City Mayor on August 13, 2024 and was returned **UNSIGNED** on September 6, 2024. Relative to this, Section 54(b) of the Local Government Code states that:

"SECTION 54. Approval of Ordinances. - (a) Every ordinance enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Sangguniang Panlungsod, or Sangguniang bayan shall be presented to the provincial governor or city or municipal mayor, as the case may be. If the local chief executive concerned approves the same, he shall affix his signature on each and every page thereof; otherwise, he shall veto it and return the same with his objections to the Sanggunian, which may proceed to reconsider the same. The Sanggunian concerned may override the veto of the local chief executive by two-thirds (2/3) vote of all its members, thereby making the ordinance or resolution effective for all legal intents and purposes.

(b) The veto shall be communicated by the local chief executive concerned to the Sanggunian within fifteen (15) days in the case of a province, and <u>ten (10) days in the case of a city or a municipality; otherwise,</u> <u>the ordinance shall be deemed approved as if he had signed it</u>."</u>
